The fourth issue of **Rosa Mercedes 04: Coincidences in Prepositions** is now online! This concludes the publication program of the same name that has been developing over the past months through Zoom events and a series of Harun Farocki screenings at the UP Vargas Museum in Manila. Conceived by **Renan Laru-an** and **titre provisoire (Cathleen Schuster/Marcel Dickhage)**, the program aims to review questions, propositions, and solutions that have been set up in the dis/continuities of many colonial milieus. Contributors to the new issue include **Nora M. Alter, Christoph Balzar, Amy Lien/Enzo Camacho, Alice Creischer, Glenn Diaz, Abdul Nazir bin Harith Fadzillah, Farabi Fakih, Patrick Flores, Ramon Guillermo, Doreen Mende, Ho Tzu Nyen & Ying Sze Pek, Zikri Rahman, Andreas Siekmann, Rachel Thompson, Lim Paik Yin, and Soyoung Yoon**.

Currently on **Rosa Mercedes 05 (Against "Special Operation" Images)** we publish two appeals to Ukrainian visual producers, citizen archivists, reporters etc. to document the war in Ukraine from different perspectives. **Documenting Ukraine** was initiated by historian **Timothy Snyder** and is currently awarding grants; **The Encyclopedia of War** was initiated by the **Docudays UA International Human Rights Documentary Film Festival in Kyiv**, which collects videos documenting acts of resistance. Both initiatives support the recording of history – in line with the Harun Farocki Institut's politics of evidence and documentation.

Marichka Lukianchuk is now a guest of the **Harun Farocki Residency**. This was made possible through the support of **Artists at Risk**. In 2021, the visual artist and filmmaker from Ukraine – who also works collaboratively – graduated in Interdisciplinary Arts Studies from Zuyd University of Applied Sciences in the Netherlands. Her short films *Past Future Mountain* and *Spiderweb for Shelter and Hunt* have screened at international film festivals. After the **planned 2020 Residency with Cathy Lee Crane** was postponed due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the filmmaker and artist is now coming to Berlin for three months starting in June. We are very much looking forward to working with her and having the opportunity to present her latest filmic works to Berlin audiences over the next few months. From June 2 to 19, the retrospective of Ingemo Engström's cinematic work will run at Arsenal Cinema in collaboration with HaFI. The filmmaker worked closely with Harun Farocki in the 1970s, as screenwriter and co-director of ERZÄHLEN (ABOUT NARRATION) (1975) and actress on ZWISCHEN ZWEI KRIEGEN (BETWEEN TWO WARS) (1978).
