On the occasion of <u>Anna Marziano's residency</u> at the Harun Farocki Institut, we present **FOAM OF WORLDS** on **Sunday**, **December 8 at 5 p.m. at silent green**. Marziano's ongoing essayistic film project ties in with our current research project "**Terms and Conditions**. **The Legal Form of Images**" and reflects Marziano's research into the legal dimension of political ecology. Our guest is the legal philosopher **Natascia Tosel**. The discussion, moderated by **Clio Nicastro**, will be followed by the screening of **AL LARGO** (2020) by Anna Marziano.

A short **video interview with Anna Marziano** about her cinematic practice and FOAM OF WORLDS is currently available on our **Instagram**.

On **December 20 at 8 p.m.** at the **Spoutnik cinema in Geneva**, a student collective from the Visual Arts Department of HEAD Genève of HES-SO will present "**Peripheral Territories**," a selection of video and audio works by artists from Swiss and non-Swiss universities. This public program stems from the **transversal seminar** "**Rehearsing the (extra-)jurisdiction of images**" at HEAD, which takes place in exchange with our **research project** "**Terms and Conditions.**" The imagined framework for these films' endeavours scrutinize the self-revelatory laws and structures of image-liability, creating a chain of peripheral views that span across multiple camera-subject-territories. More information will be available soon on the **cinema website** and on our website.

In *Rosa Mercedes 08: Terms and Conditions*, Clio Nicastro reports on the student exhibition at the HGB (Academy of Visual Arts Leipzig, May 21-22), a collaboration with the Photography and Media class (Ines Schaber), the Expanded Cinema class (Clemens von Wedemeyer, Mareike Bernien) and the Academy's gallery (Ilse Lafer). Code of conduct, property, and crime and ecology were the three corresponding themes.

In our online section **Showcase**, we have recently published an audio excerpt from a discussion about **Harun Farocki's radio play DAS GROSSE VERBINDUNGSROHR**, which was broadcast on WDR 3 on October 4, 1976 and in which Farocki himself took part.

1. Harun Farocki Residency: Anna Marziano

Presentation, Discussion and Screening Sunday December 8, 2024, 5 p.m.

Location: **silent green, Cupola** Free Admission. Event in English

Intertwining reflections on precariousness, mothering and political desire in relation to climate justice, **FOAM OF WORLDS** is an essay-film, gathering traces of the intellectual and sensory life of three characters: a woman, a child and their environment. The latter is constituted by a small island in the venetian lagoon, where the water doesn't stop rising up.

Marziano's presentation of some excerpts of her new film project will be followed by a conversation with philosopher of law **Natascia Tosel** (CIEG, University of Lisbon), and cultural theorist **Clio Nicastro** (HaFl), focusing on the notion of juridification as well as on labor and care. Marziano's previous film **AL LARGO** (2020, 62 min.) will be screened after the discussion.

Anna Marziano grew up in Italy. Her films question the ongoing transformations of subjects, communities, environments. Besides her studies in Political Sciences and Philosophy, Anna Marziano studied cinema in France at the Ateliers Varan (Paris) and Le Fresnoy Studio National (Tourcoing). Since 2009, she has been producing a consistent body of filmworks related to the documentary form, the essay form and the collaborative practices. Her works are screened in festivals and art-spaces throughout the world such as TIFF Wavelengths, Cinéma du Réel, IFFR Rotterdam, Experimenta Bangalore, National Gallery of Art Washington DC and received the support of Goethe-Institut / Max Mueller Bhavan and Berliner Senat. Her artistic activities also include writing and teaching. She currently lives in Catania.
